John bought land in Lee Co. Iowa in 1846.

Apparently John, his son Harlow, and his stepson James Boggs went to CA during the gold rush as they are listed in the 1850 census for Louisville, El Dorado Co., CA.

Their occupations are given as miners.

Homestead filed by John C. Barney on 3 Sep 1866 Book A p.310: The Southwest quarter of Section 19 township 11 north range 4 east base and meridian of Mount Diablo. Containing 160 acres.

While most sources give his name as John C. Barney, the voter registration list for Sutter Co. CA gave his complete name: John Cary Barney

In John's will, he left all of his property, both real estate and personal, to his wife Elizabeth. He also made her the executrix of his estate which had a value of about \$1200.00 in real estate and \$300.00 in personal property situated in Sutter Co. CA.

The Barneys took Donation Land Claim #4130 on Salt Creek near Buell.

Harlow arrived in OR on 20 Oct 1853 and settled his land claim 1 Jan 1854. -

Harlow bought land south of Walla Walla, the north half of the southwest quarter of section 5 township 6 north range 35 east of the Willamette Meridian from J & J Young and Gn Young and wife for \$100.00 in gold coin on 27 Aug 1891.

The land was in the next section over from the Valley Chapel Cemetery. Valley Chapel is a group of houses, not really a town and the cemetery is not being used anymore. It is reached by turning off of H12 west of Walla Walla at Last Chance and turning south.

Walla Walla local cemetery records had the following:

Harlow Barney who died 30 Oct 1971. He was from Lowden, that's close to Valley Chapel; also a C. Barney who died 10 Sep 1903; a Harry Barney who died in 1964; and a Pearl Mae Barney who died in 1977. - Pat Gale

Mrs. Mayberry has been an active worker in every organization which could be of benefit to her family and community.
