Joseph T. Hinkle, the subject of this sketch, was born in Cumberland County, Kentucky, November 2, 1867, and is the second son of George and Cyntha (Phelps) Hinkle, whose connections with two representatives and romantic marriage during the civil war are among the never-to-be forgotten legends of the county. When our subject was only three years old his parents left their beautiful home in Cumberland county and engaged in the mercantile business at Glasgow, Barren county. This county had not yet recovered from the ravages of the invading armies that had recently passed over it, but Mr. Hinkle, Sr., prospered until the financial crisis of 1873, when he received losses from which he could not recover.

Selling out in 1880, Mr. Hinkle with his family removed to Henry county, Missouri, and there engaged in farming for three years, when he again made a removal, this time selecting Umatilla county as his home, where his own indomitable energy and that of his wife and five boys have assured prosperity and strengthened the bonds of a happy and envied family.

Upon the arrival of the family in Oregon, our subject, who was then only fifteen years of age, spent eight months in the Willamette University, after which he returned home. Like many other boys of that age he did not appreciate the importance and usefulness of a proper amount of schooling, and as his parents indulged him in his aversion to study of all kinds, this eight months was the extent of his schooling, with exception of some fourteen months spent in common schools. In spite of his limited education, immediately upon his return, Mr. Hinkle secured a position in one of the public schools of this county, and gave such satisfaction that he was retained until May, 1891, when he accepted an editorial position on the Oregon Alliance Herald, at Pendleton. Shortly After, having proven himself a fearless reform writer, he was appointed editor-in-chief and has since conducted that paper, winning for it and for himself a position of exalted trust and honor, reflecting great credit upon the cause he has expoused, and to which he is so peculiarly fitted.

IN addition to his literary attainments, Mr. Hinkle is a good farmer and owns 320 acres of fertile land in Umatilla county. He also has the great gift of oratory that is sure to carry him to the front ranks in the political world.

Lt. Barnett from Yakima, received the silver star "For gallantry in action against the enemy near -- islands March 1, 1945. During a fierce barrage of enemy artillery fire on a hill which was occupied by a friendly infantry rifle company, Lt. Barnett, a mortar observer, immediately realized that a counter-barrage of mortar fire was necessary to silence the enemy guns. Though his observation post was under enemy sniper fire, Lt. Barnett, with complete disregard for his personal safety, worked his way forward to a point from which he could secure a better view of enemy positions. While exposed to enemy observation and fire, he directed a mortar barrage on the enemy which was so accurate and intense that the guns were silenced and the enemy destroyed. upon completing this gallant act, a sniper's bullet found its mark, mortally wounding Lt. Barnett. His bravery and devotion to duty were an inspiration to all Men with whom he served"

"During a fierce barrage of enemy artillery fire on a hill which was occupied by a friendly infantry rifle company, Lieutenant Barnett, a mortar observer, immediately realized, that a counter-barrage of mortar fire was necessary to silence the enemy guns. Though his observation post was under enemy sniper fire, Lieutenant Barnett, with complete disregard for his personal safety, worked his way forward, to a point from which he could secure a better view of enemy positions. While exposed to enemy observation and fire, he directed a mortar barrage on the enemy, which was so accurate and intense that the guns were silenced, and the enemy destroyed. Upon completing this gallant act, a sniper's bullet found its mark, mortally wounding Lieutenant Barnett."
