Ralph Walter Passes Following Brief Illness

Ralf Wilford Walter, a resident of this section of Oregon for 57 years, passed away at his home in South Milton last Friday evening about 9:30, following a very short illness. He became ill Friday morning of a heart disorder and his passing was so unexpected it was a shock to his many friends.

Mr. Walter was born in Wayne County, Ohio, April 5, 1875, and came to Oregon with his parents 57 years ago. They traveled over the prairies in two covered wagons, leaving Kansas July 8, 1882. The party reached the Grande Ronde valley in October where they stopped for a month before crossing over the Blue Mountains by way of the old Thomas and Ruckles Road.

Surviving relatives include his widow, Mrs. Cora Walter; three daughters, Mrs. Erwin Beard of Walla Walla, Mrs. Vance Morris of Milton and Miss Esther Walter of Portland; and four brothers, Clarence, Oscar and Warren Walter, all of Milton.

Funeral services were held at 2:30 o'clock Sunday afternoon from the Christian Church, Rev. Kenneth C. Hendricks officiating. Interment followed at Milton IOOF Cemetery.

My name is Sheri Cowart Carlberg, and I am writing to you because I came across information that you might want to correct. Your e-mail address was the only one I could find in the description of family history for the Demaris line. If I have reached you in error, my apologies.

My mother and father were Leonard and Frances Cowart. Mother was Frances Helen Demaris, first daughter of Harvey and Grace Birdsell Demaris (Clements).

I noticed some of the information described Dad as having died and been

buried in Maricopa County, Arizona. While he died there, he was cremated and is now buried with my Mom in the Milton-Freewater Cemetery. Mother died, rather than Santa Fe, NM, in Issaquah, Wa. The dates are correct, just not the locations. I recently had a memorial service and interment for them in Milton-Freewater. Their grave is near Grace Demaris Clements, Ila Jean (Demaris) Gibbons and Wilbur Gibbons, and several rows away from Joseph and Lucy Cowart, Leonard's parents.

Hope this helps. I enjoyed reading a little of the history when I found it on-line and it helped me recall names I had heard and relatives of my folks' that had visited and written them during my childhood. I also recall Cheryl Ann Demaris, Merle's daughter, as she and I went to Whitworth at the same time in the mid-60's.

LaVerne (Verne) Demaris of 904 S.E. Second Ave., Milton-Freewater, died April 26, 2010, in Walla Walla at the age of 92. Funeral services will not be held at Verne's request. Munselle-Rhodes, 902 S. Main St., M-F is in charge of the arrangements.

LaVerne was born in Cache Hollow, Milton, on May 25, 1917, the son of James H. and Grace Irene (Birdwell) Demaris. He attended schools in the area and graduated from McLoughlin High School. In 1936, he entered the CCC and served there until 1937 as a Sawyer. Verne joined the U.S. Marine Corps on Dec. 11, 1941. He served in the Asiatic-Pacific Theater from January 1943 to May 1945. He saw action on Bouganville Island, British Solomon Islands, Guam, Marianna Islands, Iwo Jima and Volcano Islands. He was wounded in action on Iwo Jima with phosphorus burns. He was honorably discharged from the U.S. Marine Corps on Sept. 17, 1945, as a sergeant. He received a Purple Heart, a Commendation Medal, a WWII Victory Medal, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal, a Combat Action Ribbon, and a Honorable Service Lapel Pin for his service to our country.

He returned to M-F and was employed by Rogers Cannery and Key Equipment for many years until his retirement. He also operated an orchard on the South Fork of the Walla Walla River. LaVerne married Juanita Harris Ramsey of M-F. She later preceded him in death. He is survived by step-granddaughters Dana Pace of Bothel, WA, Cami Eastep and Dr. Melisa Ramsey-Carmi of Walla Walla WA; and a nephew James Gibbons, and a niece Sherry Marr.

His parents, sisters Jean and Frances and stepsons Dan and Dennis all preceded him in death.

JOHN AND EMILY HEREFORD

EARL HERBERT HEREFORD was born on the Walla Walla River near Milton, Oregon August 25, 1893, before Milton and Freewater were incorporated into one town. He was an only child of FRANKLIN E. and IRENE (DEMARIS) HEREFORD whose parents both his and hers, crossed the plains the same year, 1863, in seperate wagon trains.

The grandparents of EARL HEREFORD, JOHN and EMILY (MORGAN) HEREFORD, withe their two children, JIM and MARY, joined a wagon train in St. Louis, Missouri. The train consisted of one hundred

wagons pulled mostly by oxen, for the long trek west. They settled in the Willamette Valley, in Linn County. I believe where, three more children were born: FRANKLIN E., - ALBERT, - and GEORGE.

In the mid 1870's they came to Central Oregon, settling on the upper Ochoco, above the Ochoco Cemetery, which was part of his land. Grandpa was buried there a month before I was born. My uncle JIM HEREFORD has a little daughter buried there too.

Later my grandma married a photographer named PEARSON. Some people mistakenly call it the PEARSON place, but he owned no part of it. They finally separated.

Uncle JIM and with his family moved to the Walla Walla country.

My grandma also lived there awhile. Uncle ALBERT was a conductor on the Union Pacific.

Finally the rest of the family moved away.

My grandpa and grama, ENOCH and EMILY (ROBERTS) DEMARIS crossed the plains later the same year as the Herefords, 1863. The Demaris family made the trek from Iowa and joined the train at St. Louis, Missouri. Grandpa's parents were in the same train. All settled on the Walla Walla River near Milton, Oregon, where three children were born to grandma and grandpa. JOHN, 1864; SARAH, 1866; and IRENE 1868. ROBERT was born later. They finally came to Central Oregon in 1877 and settled on Mill Creek.

Grandpa ENOCH died a year later and was buried in the Mill Creek Cemetery. Grandma later married CLINT ORRICK. They bought land on Mill Creek where they lived until both died.

The Mill Creek property has belonged to someone in the family for over 100 years.

On July 4, 1887, FRANKLIN E. and IRENE C. DEMARIS were married in her mother's home on West Branch, near Mitchell, Oregon. He had a homestead. After a few years he sold his relinquishment. They moved to Milton, Oregon, where EARL an only child was born.

JESSE PRATT YANCEY JR.

JESSE PRATT YANCEY, JR. born September 1857 in Carson City, Nevada. He was the son of JESSE PRATT YANCEY SR. who came west in 1853. JESSE moved to Prineville in 1880 where he engaged in ranching and stock business, in partnership with his brother STEVE. He also operated a horse team freight business from The Dalles to Prineville. Together they freighted the first equipment for the Prineville Power Plant. Jesse lived on his ranch where the Ochoco Lake now stands. The ranch house and barn were located just east of the dam. JESSE married CELIA FOREN October 10, 1883. She was the neice of DAVE PRINE who started the City of Prineville. They had four children, CECIL ROY, JESSE LLOYD, WILLIAM WARREN and RUTH LOUISA. CECIL died in 1904 at 20 years of age from an accidental handgun incident. He was not married. LLOYD married IRENE CASCADE FULLER (AUNT RENE), they had no children. He died in July 1963. RUTH married LUTHER BARNEY. They had three children MARION, ROBERT and MARY ELLEN.

WILLIAM WARREN (SLIM) YANCEY, born May 1894 in Lathrop, California while his mother and father were on vacation. Warren worked for his father in the ranching business until he joined the army in 1918. He served in France as an enlisted man in the Army Air Corps during World War I. After he returned to Prineville by way of the Prineville Railroad from Redmond. He was the first paying passenger on this railroad. He was appointed Prineville Marshall and later served as deputy Sheriff of Crook County under his uncle STEVE YANCEY. Warren joined the Oregon State Highway Patrol in 1927 and later became a charter member of the Oregon State Police. He served with the State Police until 1939 when he was promoted to captain and commanded the Eastern District at Baker. In 1939 he returned to Prineville where he engaged in ranching on his ranch on upper Mill Creek bounded between the HARRY NEAL place and the Hereford ranch. He moved to Portland during World War II where he retired from Hyster Company in 1958.

**ROBERT AND MARY DEMARIS**

**ROBERT DEMARIS, youngest son of ENOCH and ALMEDA DEMARIS, was born in Davis County, Iowa. January 11, 1876. when he was five months old his family moved to Central Oregon, settling on Mill Creek. ENOCH died when ROBERT was two, and ALMEDA married CLINTON ORRICK in 1881.**

**ROBERT grew to manhood in the Mitchell, Oregon country. He attended the Gable Creek school, later working on ranches and herding sheep.**

ROBERT's brother JOHN, freighted from The Dalles to Prineville and when Robert was eleven he drove four-horse teams. He was too small to reach the brake so they would tie a rope to the brake, tie ROBERT to the seat, and place his wagon in the middle of the line of wagons.

ROBERT homesteaded in Conant Basin in 1910 and met and married MARY H. BAKER in 1913.

MARY was born August 18, 1874 in North Bristol, Wisconsin. She was a descendant of EDWARD BAKER who arrived in Massachusetts in 1630 with Governor Winthrop. MARY was a graduate of an Academy in Madison and taught school in Wisconsin and Oregon for many years. She taught the Sheep Rock, Roberts, Post, Shotgun, Upper Mill Creek, Lower Mill Creek and Conant Basin schools. MARY was also a linotype operator and worked for the Brethren Publishing Co. in Elgin, Illinois, and Donnelly Publishing Co. in Chicago.

MARY homesteaded on the north side of Mule Deer Mountain near Newsom Creek. For many years ROBERT and MARY operated the two ranches, living on one ranch and then the other.

In 1928 they moved to Riverside Ranch, below Post. This was a night stopover for cattle and horse herds. It was here ALICE DAY PRATT spent her last night in the Post country.

ROBERT and MARY had one daughter, MARY ALMEDA, born May 16, 1917 in Prineville.

In 1932 the family moved to Prineville so MARY ALMEDA could finish high school.

In Prineville MARY was active in the Community Church and the Library Club, being one of several women who worked so hard to get a library in Prineville. ROBERT 'live' trapped beaver for the Forest Service.

In 1938 they built a home on South Main Street, living there until their deaths, ROBERT in April, 1963, and MARY in February, 1965.
