I happened upon your web site doing a search for my family tree. I have a letter typed in 1932 to my grandmother, Gertrude Pentland Millikan from her father, Edwin Chester Pentland.

It details information about his family coming from England to Oregon (via Ohio) in the early and mid 1800s. Edwin's father, Robert, was a miller, in fact millers go back 5 generations in that family, according to the letter.

My great grandmother was Gertrude Hayes Pentland (Edwin's wife) and her father was Seth Whipple Pentland, but not with Sarah Finley, but another, Lydia Jewett. He had 3 wives in total.

I also found a WPA interview with a Ruby Hayes Standish which gives more information about the Hayes family with dates but also mentions a story about Eliza Brandon, R.C. Finley's daughter.
