It Points to Skelly

Looks as if He Was the Murderer.

Traces of Blood were found on his Hands and Arms -- The Killing Occurred Directly After the Quarrel.

Missoula, July 5 -- Coroner Hayes returned tonight from Thompson, where he went to investigate the killing of Chance Garred, whose murder was reported in the Standard today. Coroner Hayes conducted an inquest this morning and the investigation brought out substantially the facts as stated in the Standard's special dispatch from Thompson in today's paper.

Norton, the saloonman in whose place Garred died, testified that Garred, Skelly, Angus Smith and William Odette went into the yard back of the saloon together. The next that he noticed was Skelly hurrying out through the saloon. Skelly had traces of blood on his hands and arms and this aroused Norton's suspicions. He

looked into the back yard and found Garred very weak and bleeding to death. Before a doctor could be summoned Garred died.

Another witness, Stiles, testified to looking over a fence and seeing the men above named engaged in a wordy quarrel, but he saw no weapons.

Other witnesses testified to the details of the affair, and the jury's verdict was that Garred came to his death from excessive bleeding caused by a wound in his arm, inflicted by some blunt weapon in the hands of unknown parties. The verdict instructs the coroner to hold George Skelly, William Odette and Angus Smith for further examination. This was done and County Attorney Denny this afternoon conducted a preliminary examination of the three men before Justice Adams. The evidence points to Skelly as the man who inflicted the wound.

Skelly Murder Trial

Missoula, July 23 -- The Skelly murder trial will be begun in the district court tomorrow morning, and all of the witnesses and others interested are up from Thompson Falls tonight. Constable Massey brought up the clothing of the dead man. Garred, and other exhibits in the case. The trial will be the most interesting one that has occurred in this district in a long time. Skelly is accused of killing Chauncey Garred in a fight at Thompson Falls on the morning of July 4, and the general opinion is that he is guilty. His attorneys, however, think that the case against him is not a strong one. What the line of defense is to be is not known at this time, but it is presumed that it will deal largely with the threats that Garred is said to have made against Skelly.
