There were a few early settlers about whom there is little available record.

In 1860 U. Garred settled on the Walla Walla River about 5 miles above Milton. Garred's later became a part of the business community of Milton.

In the same year, 1860, S. P. Whitely settled on the river 3 miles below Garred. It is said that the Whitely home was the first house in the valley to be painted.

Dasher Identified

The appended self-explanatory letter comes from Milton's Ed Hodgen, who is famed for his ability to confuse facts with fiction in all matters except history. Where he sticks fairly close to facts:

"Dear Roving Reporter: some weeks ago your punk column had an item about an old picture in Athena of a race horse named Dasher. who was running races around Walla Walla in 1865. It seems you knew nothing about him except his name. So I take great pleasure in informing you that Dasher was owned by Hank Garred, who was an early settler on the Walla Walla river above the forks.

"He was the great grandfather of Dennis Grooms, who lives in No Man's land (between Milton and Freewater), Mr and Mrs Grooms have a picture of Dasher and also one of a race horse named Johnnie. Owned by the same man.

"Oldtimers will remember Henry Garred, who was a son of Hank, and was a jockey.

Won Races

"An unidentified Walla Wallan once approached Hank with a proposition to send Dasher to a big race in San Francisco. The owner said no, because nobody but his son Henry had ridden the animal. Then the Walla Wallan agreed to take Henry along as jockey and bought the boy a fine uniform of the best satin. Henry was very proud of his outfit. He was 14 then.

Dasher won the big race.

"From what I learn Dasher never lost a race.

Johnnie

"The other Hank Garred horse, Johnnie, lived to be 26 years old and lost only two races in his lifetime.

"On each July 4 over a period of 18 consecutive years, Johnnie won his Fourth of July celebration race. His last race and victory was in 1906. The family was much attached to the animal and gave him the greatest care until death ended his career.

"In the pictures of Grooms own Dasher appears as a long, slim animal, but Johnnie looks more like a good pack horse than a racer. They also have a picture of Mr and Mrs Hank Garred, which must have been taken long ago. Hank wore chin whiskers six inches long. (Note – more of a goatee than the full growth of whiskers common in those days).

"Hank settled on the river above Milton on the place now owned by Mr and Mrs John Ross.

Anderson W Garred was born in Lawrence County, Kentucky, June 15, 1832. His father was a native of Greenbrier county, Virginia. From there he went to Kentucky, where he married Miss mary Wilson, a Native of Virginia. When Anderson was seven years of age his parents moved to missouri. After remaining there until 1849, they returned to Kentucky, where they lived until their deaths. Anderson W., of whom we write, is the seventh of twelve children. In June 1863, Mr Garred came to Minnesota, arriving at Winona the 29th, remaining there until August, 1864, when he came to Mower county, and bought a farm in section 27, Lansing township, where he lived until July 1874, when he moved to his present home in section 33. Mr Garred has a nice farm, containing 160 acres.

Mr Garred was married in 1852, to Elizabeth M. Dyer, born in Lawrence county, Kentucky, in 1832. There has been born to this union eight children, George P., Wiley, James G., Rebecca B., Joseph P., Frank S., Charles S., Andrew G.
