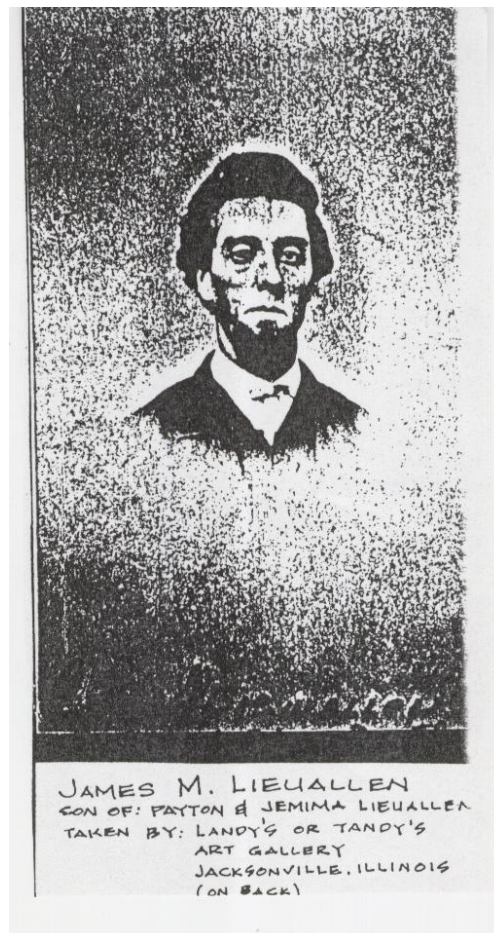

LIEUALLEN

Josiah Lieuallen was William Lieuallen's brother. Josiah came to the Weston area in 1862 and homesteaded on Wildhorse Creek. The homestead was farmed through Josiah's line by his son, George W. Lieuallen, then by George's son Alton Lieuallen, and now Alton's son, Brooks Lieuallen, still farms the homestead which became a Century Farm in 1964.

Josiah's son George W. Lieuallen also had a son, George C. Lieuallen, who farmed in the Weston area. George C. had a son, George A. Lieuallen, who now farms on Basket Mountain and in the Umapine area. {Another of George C.'s sons is Neil B. Lieuallen. Neil's son, Justin Lieuallen, currently runs cattle on Upper Dry Creek.}

Another son of Josiah was James T. Lieuallen, who moved to Adams where he not only farmed but owned a blacksmith shop and a general store. Farming in his family continued with James T.'s son, J.T. Lieuallen, Jr., then to his son, Sheldon Lieuallen; and Sheldon's sons; James, Richard and Joe Lieuallen, now farm under Lieuallen Brothers. {James T. Lieuallen, Sr. also had a son, Paul Lieuallen, and Paul's daughter, Pauline, married Harold Thompson. Lieuallen Farms in Adams is now operated by John Thompson, Pauline and Harold's son.}
