Roy Elwayne Lieuallen

Roy Elwayne Lieuallen, 88, former Chancellor of the Oregon State System of Higher Education, died Wednesday, April 20, 2005.

Lieuallen was born in 1916. When he was 5 years old, his parents moved the family to Morrow County to rent wheat land. He attended a one-room schoolhouse in the area. After the family lost the farm in 1933, they moved to Ione, where he graduated from school.

After working for three years on area ranches Lieuallen earned enough money to attend Pacific University, along with a half tuition scholarship. He graduated with a bachelor of science degree in physical education. At college, he met his future wife, Barbara Wales, and they were married in Bend on Feb 20, 1943.

Lieuallen served in the US Navy on the destroyer, USS Patterson. He received a bronze star during his time in the service.

After the war, Lieuallen performed his graduate work at the University of Oregon, completing his master's degree in education administration. After graduation, he returned to a teaching position in Pilot Rock, but was then recommended for the job of registrar at Oregon College of Education (Now Western Oregon University) in Monmouth. He and his family moved to Monmouth in 1946.

In 1953, he moved to Menlo Park, CA where he received his doctorate's degree in education from Stanford University.

Late in December 1961, then--Governor Mark Hatfield designated Lieuallen, at the recommendation of the State Board of Higher Education, to assume the job of Chancellor of the State System. The family moved to Eugene where they remained for 20 1/2 years at Tree Tops, the official Chancellor's residence. He resigned from his position at the end of June 1982.

After retirement, he was drafted by the World Bank to go to China in 1984 to advise the government on modernizing the teacher training colleges. While in China, Lieuallen, his wife and grandson, was hurried out of Tianamen Square in June of 1989 as the rioting began and caught the last flight out of Beijing. In all, he made eight trips to China, most to the interior where few westerners had previously visited. Lieuallen is survived by his family, friends, and colleagues.

Roy C. Gammell

Roy C. Gammell, 72, of Brownsville, Ore., died of a massive stroke on Thursday, Nov. 9, 2000, in Eugene.

A wake will be held at 6:30 p.m., Wednesday, at the Major Family Funeral Home, 112 North A Street, Springfield. The funeral will be 2 p.m. Thursday, at Willamette National Cemetery in Portland.

Born in Pendleton, Mr. Gammell grew up at Heppner, then enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1943, at age 14, after forging his father's signature to serve in World War II. After his 1946 discharge, he returned to Oregon, married Betty DePew of Long Creek, in 1947, and became a rancher at Ritter.

He was recalled to active duty in 1950, this time by the Marine Corps, to serve in the Korean Conflict. While serving in Korea, Gammell established an orphanage for children who had lost their parents during the conflict. After discharge he returned to Ritter for a time, but decided to join the Army a few years later, beginning a long and distinguished career with that service in 1955.

During his time in the Army he served four tours in Vietnam. His numerous military awards include several for valor and the country's third highest, the Silver Star, which he earned in Vietnam while with the 101st Airborne Division. During his Army career, he achieved that service's highest enlisted rank of command sergeant major.

Gammell's peacetime assignments include the 27th Infantry, 501st Infantry, 101st Airborne, 9th Infantry, 28th Civil Affairs and 7th Special Forces. In addition, he had tours of duty in Germany and Japan, as well as with the ROTC detachment at Seattle University. His last active-duty assignment before he retired was with the ROTC detachment at the University of Oregon in Eugene from 1974 through 1977.

In addition to the Silver Star, Gammell's list of military awards and decorations includes: Bronze Star Medal with six Oak Leaf Clusters (one with "V" device for valor), Air Medal with three Oak Leaf Clusters, Purple Heart with three Oak Leaf Clusters, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters (one with "V" device for valor), Good Conduct Medal (six awards), National Defense Service Medal with one Oak Leaf Cluster, Presidential Unit Citation with two Oak Leaf Clusters, European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal with three battle stars, American Campaign Medal, World War II Victory Medal, Army of Occupation Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Republic of Vietnam Commendation Medal, Vietnam Cross of Gallantry, Vietnam Civil Actions Medal, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal with two battle stars, and the Korean Service Medal. He also earned the Combat Infantryman's Badge, the Master Parachutist Badge, the Senior Aircraft Crewman's Badge, the Pathfinder's Badge and the Driver/Mechanic Badge.

After retiring from the Army, Gammell was the district manager for the Junction City Water Control District from 1980 through 1995. He had a B.S. degree in horticulture from the University of Maryland and an A.A. in criminal justice from Lane Community College in Eugene. Gammell is survived by his wife, Betty, and their six children: Michael Gammell and James Gammell of Reno, Nev., Patrick Gammell of Junction City, Carrie Gammell of Naperville, Ill.; Daniel Gammell of Salem, Ore.; and Janie Auer of Alamogordo, New Mexico.
