Lieuallen was born Nov. 1, 1916, on Sunnyside Road north of Milton-Freewater, the daughter of Floyd and Mildred Shields Coffman. She grew up on a family farm on Dry Creek, attended Dry Creek County School and in 1935 she graduated from McLaughlin Union High School in M-F on Nov. 18, 1942. She married Ronald "Swede" Lieuallen in M-F. The couple lived and worked on the Lieuallen farm for 23 years until his death on Feb. 23, 1965. Lieuallen remained on the farm until her death.

Throughout her life, she cooked for harvest crews and did seamstress work for many in the community. After her husband died, she began working for the Athena School District as a bus driver and then as a cook until her retirement.
