The youngest of nine children born to Elwood Fremont and Arizona Hotchkiss Straughan. She spent her early days on the family farm at Birch Creek, south of Pendleton. She graduated in 1924 from Pendleton High School and in 1928 from the University of Oregon where she was a member of Alpha Delta Pi.

She taught several years each at the Adams and Heppner high schools and did graduate work during the summers at Stanford University.

In April 18, 1934, she married Otis M. Lieuallen in Pendleton, moved into the farm home south of Adams, and lived there for more than 65 years.

The Lieuallens enjoyed playing bridge, attending sports events and were active in Wildhorse Grange. Mr. Lieuallen died in 1986.

She was a member of First Christian Church in Pendleton, Adams Ladies Club and the Daughters of the American Revolution.

Mrs. Lieuallen's home and yard sported many plants and flowers. She enjoyed corresponding with relatives and in later years extensively researched the genealogical lines of her family and that of her husband.

As an English teacher, her words were chosen with care - she said exactly what she meant. It was very unusual for her to say a word even remotely unkind about anyone or anything.

Survivors include three sons, Donald and Russell Lieuallen, both of Adams, and Robert Lieuallen, of Pendleton; four grandchildren, two stepgrandchildren and seven step great grandchildren.

WESTON-- Robert G. Blomgren, 79, of Weston died in a Pendleton hospital Saturday, where he had been confined for 10 days.

Blomgren was born March 13, 1887, in Boelus, Neb. He came to Weston when he was 16. He married Anita Kirkpatrick in 1915; she died in 1933. In 1943 he married Lena Lieuallen Adkins in Weston. He was a farmer for a number of years in the Weston area, later doing carpentry work. He retired from Lamb Weston 10 years ago.

Besides his wife, at the home, he is survived by two sons, Robert G. Blomgren Jr. of Portland and Joe Blomgren of Forks, Wash.; three daughters, Mrs. Marvin (Merna) Vancil of Mount Vernon, Ore., Mrs Duane (Patsy) Duffy and Mrs. Kenneth (Georgia Schisler, both of Walla Walla; a sister, Mrs Ina Barnes of Weston; three brothers, E.
